MINUTES OF MEETING - Thursday, August 22, 2019

MSB 214 1:00 – 3:00 pm

The agenda was approved as amended.

Public comments: Dr. Jones expressed his appreciation for the work of the Math Division. He requested that work block forms be submitted and offered information about the A2MEND program for black male students.

Blustein gave a Chair Report that included an update on last year's goals, proposed goals for 2019-2020, an update on the fall schedule, information on the Fall 2019 schedule and enrollments, and a report on the summer Statistics training/workshop. She mentioned some developments regarding AB 705 implementation in LACCD. Key conclusions from the discussion included:

- The follow-up Statistics training will be postponed from Sept. 13 to some time in October (focus on hypothesis tests). Blustein will provide a training (Sept. 6) for statistics tutors.
- We will consider an update/revision of Math 122. We will not pursue a 7-unit combined Elementary/Intermediate class. If LACCD approves new "subjects" like "Math – noncredit" and "Math – Basic Skills – noncredit" we will consider the possibilities.
- Several instructors are willing and eager to offer their office hours to students needing academic advisement.
- We will consider OER for Math 245.
- Division members were asked to investigate model Math Lab/tutoring facilities for purposes of the BUG for the planned new library/student center building.
- Jamie Jenson agreed to serve as the Math liaison for with the PR office for social media.
