Partnerships

- ❖ Bridge to the Baccalaureate Planning Grant Application: West is working with CSUDH to develop a planning grant proposal that will allow 18 months of funding to build a competitive plan for a full B2B proposal with Computer Science, Mathematics, and Science.
- ❖ Department of State Community College Initiative: West is joining Harbor, Trade, and City to develop a proposal that will bring 36 international students to the four colleges for one year of study and exposure to many aspects of American culture.
- ❖ Study Abroad: It looks like 2 of the 4 planned courses will happen. Financial Aid is playing a large role in helping to finance students. Veterans are another source.
- ❖ Global Studies and International Area Studies (Africa, Asia, Latin America, Middle East) degree programs are being submitted for the district curriculum process and LACCD BoT approval, after which they will go to CCCCCO.
- ❖ Met with CSULA, PCC, and outside evaluators on newly awarded First in the World award (CSULA is lead). Our project involves faculty recruiting from amongst the current STEM Scholars, train them in effective study group techniques and growth mindset principles, and schedule/promote group study sessions particularly for introductory Science courses.
- ❖ Inglewood Library, Inglewood Community Adult School, and Inglewood American Jobs Center + West = the computer literacy cooperative. Many adults in the community need help understanding how to use smart phones, tablets, computers, searching the web, completing online forms, email, social networking, and basics of Word/Excel/PowerPoint. Tax forms are now all online; Section 8 housing forms are now all on line. Will recruit from students to be part of pilot short-term (Jan to Mar 2016) project where they, under the supervision of partner staff, students work 1-to1 or in small groups to help community members develop essential skills.
