Partnerships

- ❖ Vancouver Film School
- ❖ University of West Los Angeles—enhancing the skills of international skills, lower division GE at West and business at UWLA, potential for partnerships with universities in China
- ❖ Charles R Drew University of Medicine and Science—connect with Upward Bound Math Science, connect with S-STEM, tours, speakers, summer undergraduate research experiences, West to CDU for baccalaureate in health sciences
- ❖ Year Up—a national program that in the last couple of year has been seeking community colleges as partners (Maricopa, Miami Dade, etc.). Now interested in Los Angeles and West. Their program involves recruiting a cohort of 40 under-resourced 18 to 24 year-olds, enrolling them in a six month college credit boot camp, recruiting employers in the area to intern these participants, provide supportive services, and transition participants into employment or self-employment.

Submissions

- ❖ Pathways Project—If successful, West will join other community colleges in a national effort to enhance the development of educational pathways through community colleges to achieve both transfer and employment.
- ❖ California LAW—the California Bar is concerned that the law community does not reflect the ethnic diversity of the population of the state. Using certain IGETC courses as a base, they are looking for community college partners to recruit and mentor students into a BA and JD programs.

Awards

- ❖ ED FIPSE First in the World with CSULA. A significant number of community college students do not succeed because they meet obstacles to progress and do not know how to overcome those obstacles. As a result they withdraw from class or underperform and earn low or even failing grades. Research led by Carol Dweck and others suggests that the way institutions and teachers approach students and offer them praise and encouragement can develop positive growth mindsets that significantly enhance student performance and sense of belonging to the academy. Our project will focus on peer tutors conducting group study sessions as a catalyst for both reinforcing basic STEM course knowledge and for conveying growth mindset principles. 4 years, \$592,288
