COLLEGE READINESS PROGRAM



The West LA College Readiness Program orients students to college life and assists them in identifying their skills, exploring careers, choosing a major, and creating an education plan.

The program consists of six free online classes. Speak to a Noncredit Counselor to learn how you can earn a College Readiness Certificate.

Due to COVID, SYNCH classes are taught online with real time meetings. Students must log on at the specified days and times. Asynch classes meet online with NO real time meetings. Students MUST log on the first day of class.

1) Introduction to Post-Secondary Education BSICSKL 075CE (Asynch)

This course introduces students to the opportunities, benefits of college and essential information to successfully navigate their transition to college.

2) Academic Guidance BSICSKL 005CE (Asynch)

Students will research and document their educational and career goals and requirements develop an action plan to achieve them in a specific time frame, and learn to self-evaluate and reevaluate their progress in implementing their action plan and achieving their goals.

3) Success in Online and Hybrid classes BSICSKL 105CE (Asynch)

Students will learn how to access and be successful in their online classes, explore using programs such as their student portal, email, CANVAS and Cranium Café. Also learn mindful practices and skills needed to succeed in an online environment.

4) Industry Overview & Career Opportunities BSICSKL073CE (Asynch)

This course provides students with the basic research and networking skills to become well-informed job seekers so they can effectively prepare for their career and become employed.

5) Computer Skills Voc Ed 288 (Synch) and Voc ED 290CE (Asynch)

All new students are strongly encouraged to enroll in these classes to improve your computer skills.

6) Foundations: Study Skills BSICKL027CE (Asynch)

This course will help students identify their preferred learning styles and recognize their strengths and weaknesses to increase successful habits for effective studying, memorizing, and retaining information.
