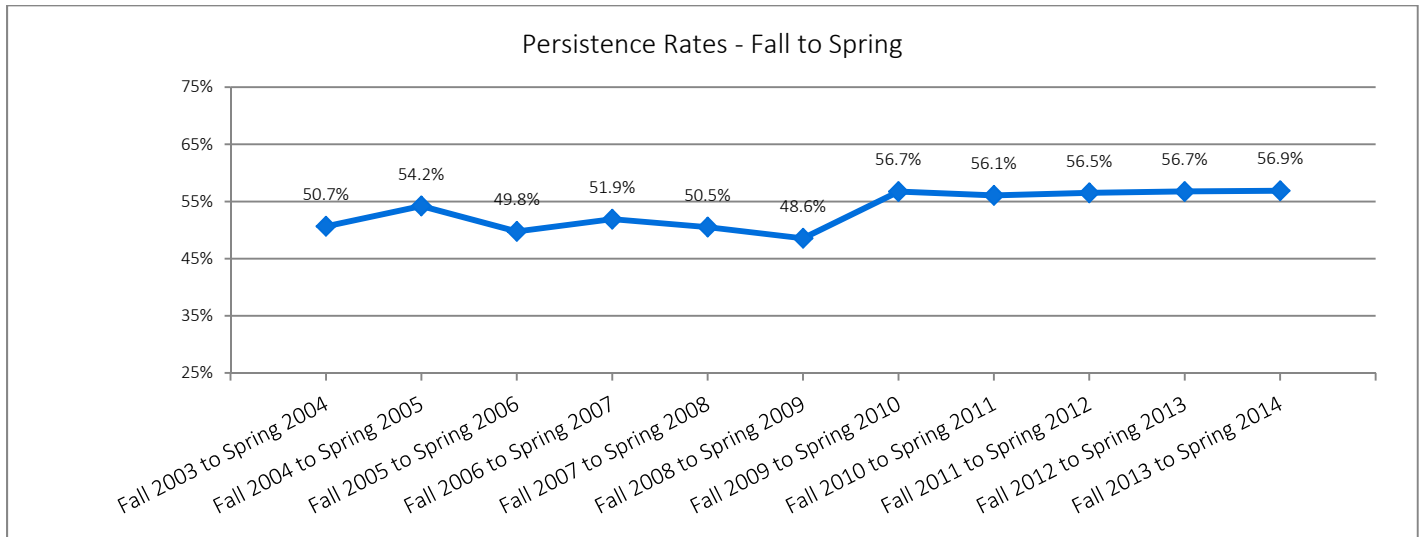

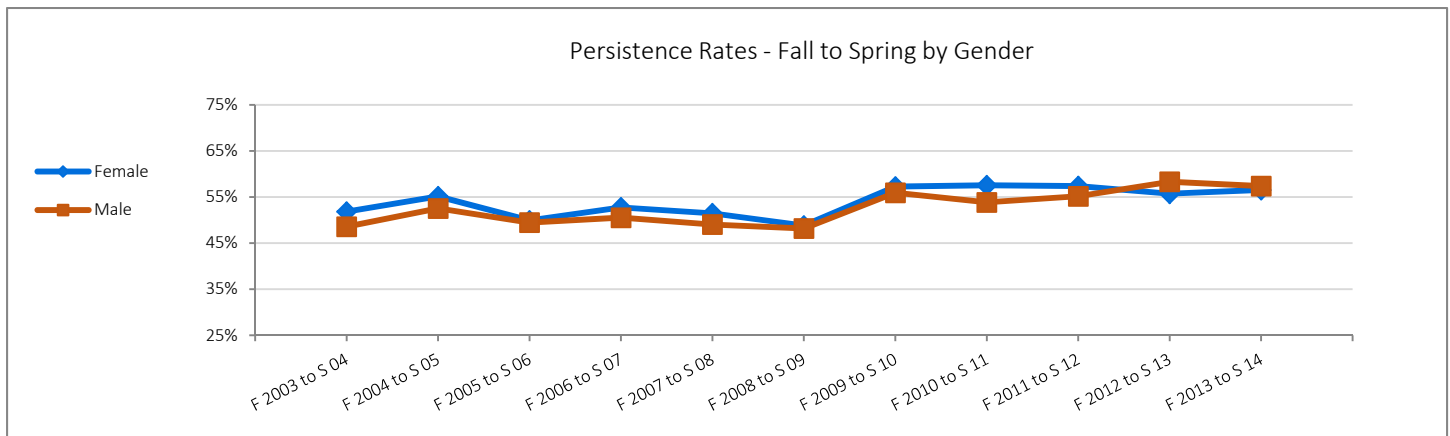

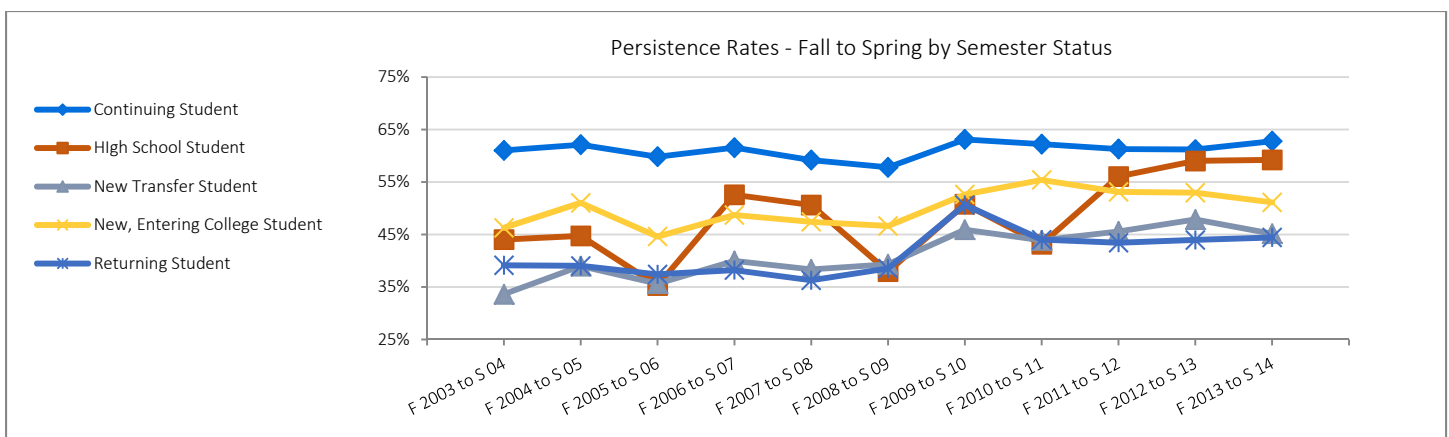

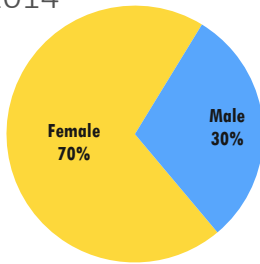

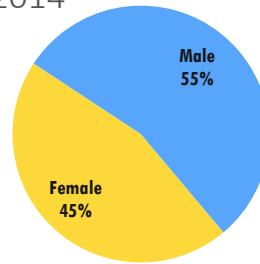
All Awards by Type



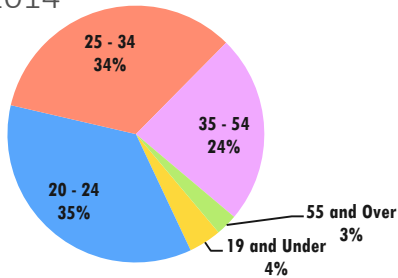
Associates Degrees by Gender
2013-2014



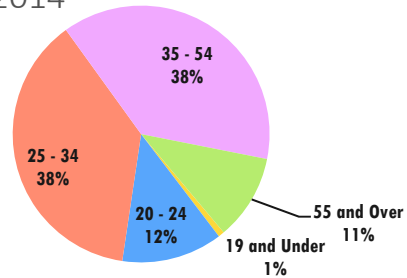
Certificates by Gender
2013-2014



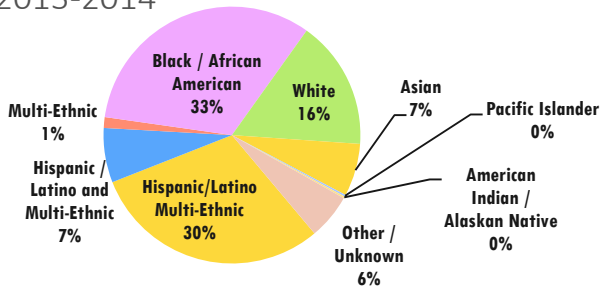
Associates Degrees by Age
2013-2014



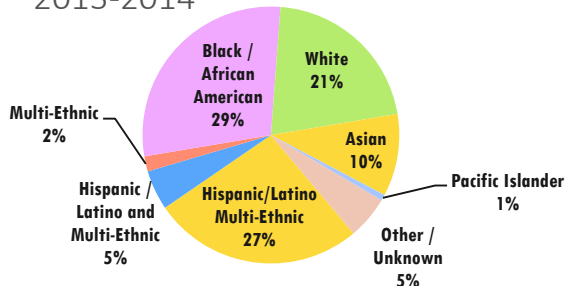
Certificates by Age

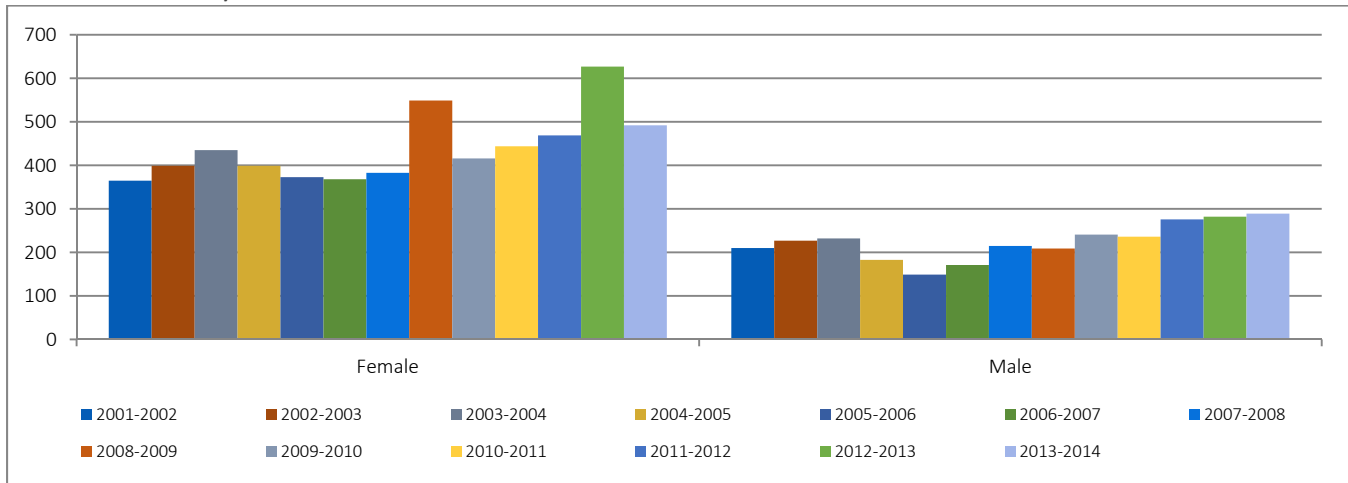

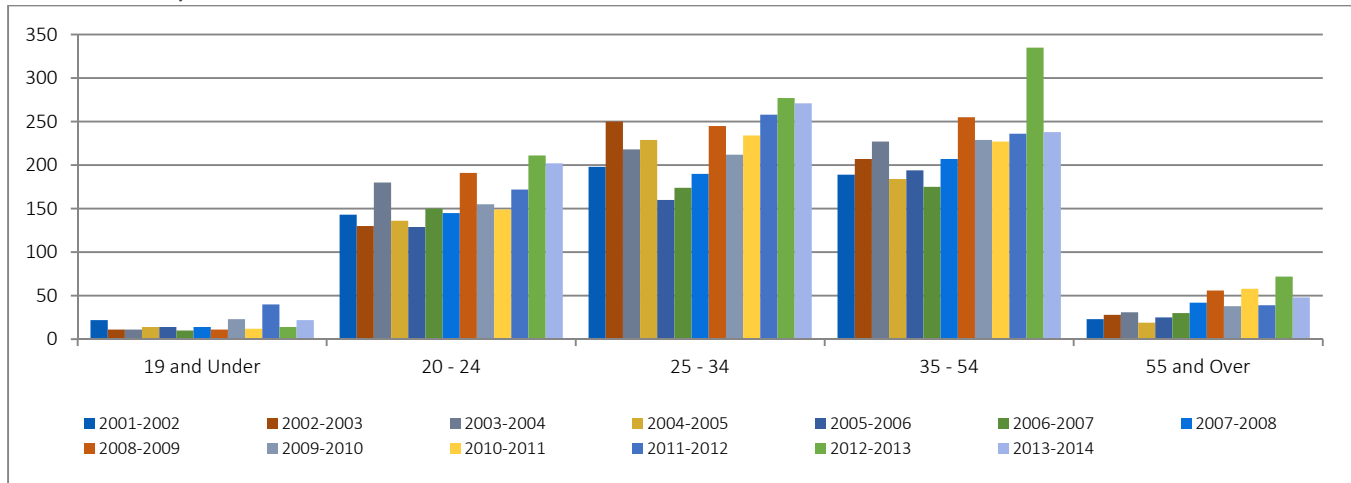

All Awards by Year



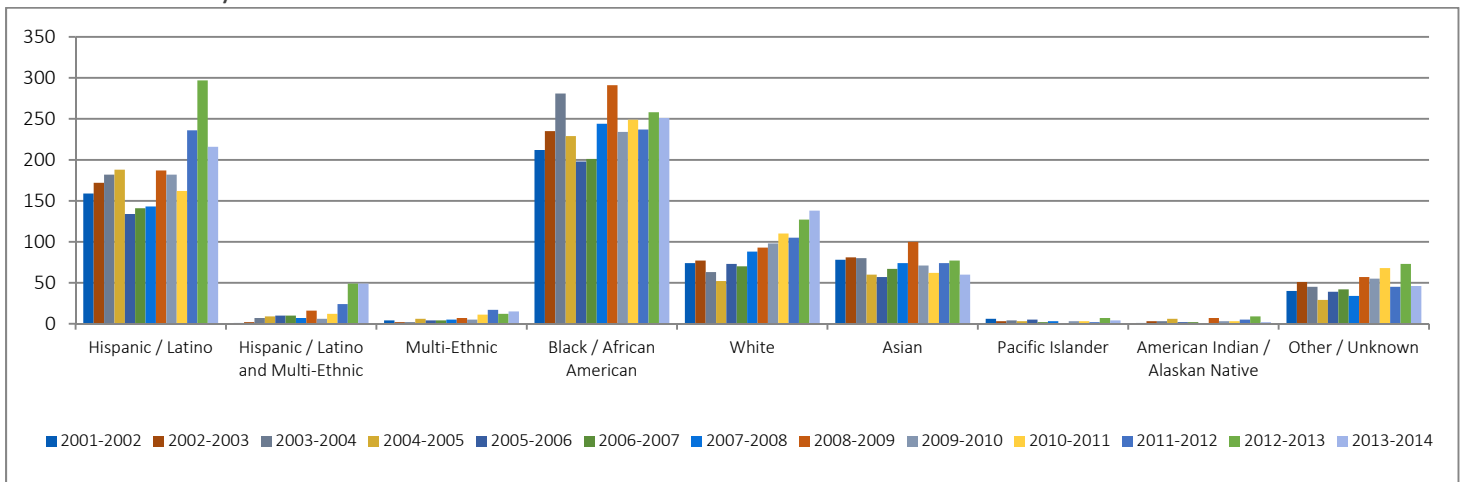

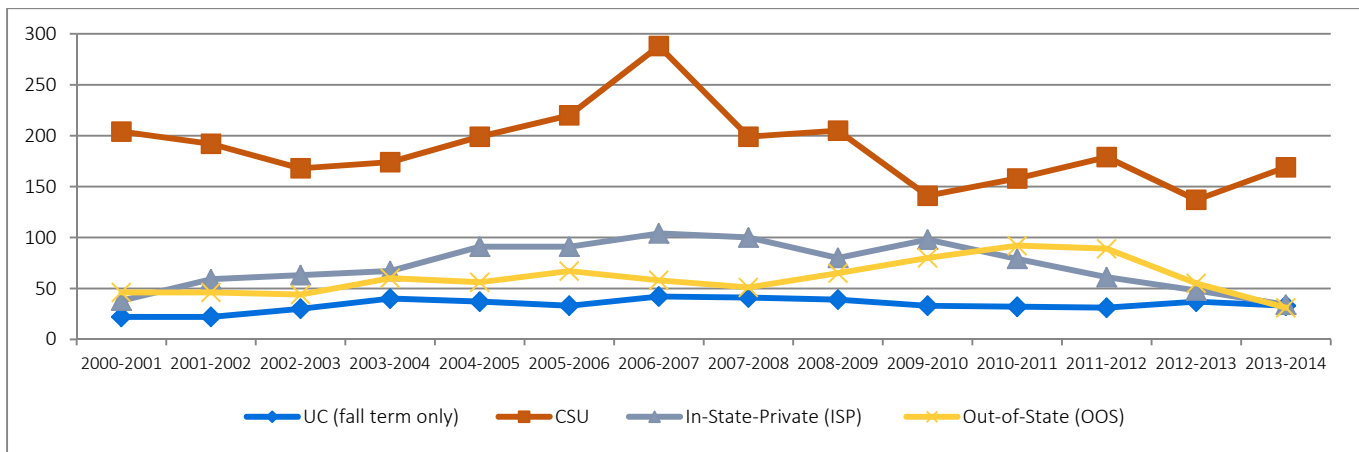

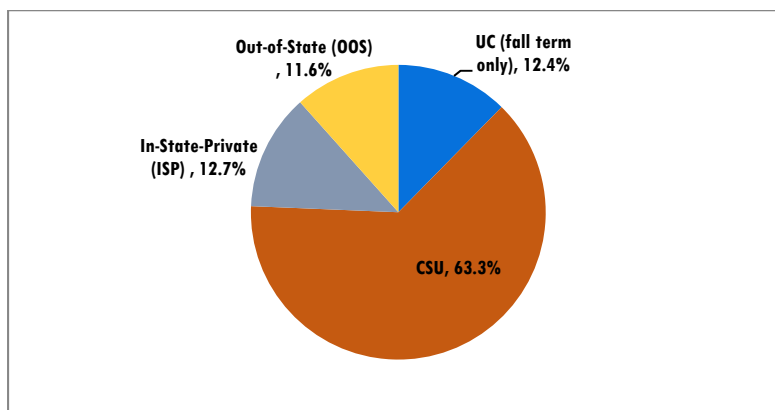
