California Community College Update: M. Quiaoit

The Chancellors office is working to reorganize to more closely resemble the integrative planning model being implemented at the local colleges. The Partnership Resource Team will take a look at the Chancellors office with respect to BSI/Equity and SSSP and conduct an analysis then make recommendations.

The Initiatives such as OEI and CAI are moving forward.

OEI: About 70 colleges are signed onto CANVASS. There is some work that needs to be done as it concerns residency requirements across district lines.

CAI: Currently in the piloting phase. Some delay in the Fall as it relates to the test being validated, but a new implementation plan is in place and things are moving forward.

There are a many initiatives working such as the educational planning tool, curriculum inventory project and others to allow for one single point of entry to include CCAPPLY, assessment, academic plan and more.

Integrative Planning:

IEPI is coordinating with Event Brite to organize several all-day meetings that will address logic models and Institutional goals at the local and CCCO program level. They will provide technical review of plans and expenditure guidelines having teams of 4-5 talk through ideas and goals. The afternoon will be a presentation of soft skills on change of management and asking programs for information concerning program coordination and crosswalks. The new SSSP/EQUITY/BSI plan is for two years.

California Legislative Information-SB 1379-Community Colleges: part-time:

The discussion included the threat to SSSP funding, but there was consensus that most colleges were addressing the contractual concerns as it relates to this bill.

Other Items

There was discussion about teaming up with Region 8 for meetings. The Region has low participation and there may be value in combining with Region 8. There was mention that other regions are doing this as well.
