CCCASSESS Update:

As a CAI Pilot college, WLAC SSSP exceeded the state targeted benchmark of 1200 tests. Successful completion of the CCCASSESS pilot testing was attributed to the SSSP staff and WLAC faculty who participated in bringing their classes for English / ESL and math assessment to the Assessment Center for testing. WLAC will continue to participate as a pilot college into the Fall term 2016 implementing the test as a state targeted date. Spring 2017 the CCCO plans to implement the test for all nine colleges in the district.

LACCD Update:

The district is working on the final language for the BOG fee waiver appeal. Additionally, the district is working on the DEC screens for the Non-Credit SSSP services. There will be a CCCO SSSP summit in September and there are plans for a SSSP Regional meeting at that time. There will be SIS training and mentor training over the next few months, more clarification is needed as to the roll out. There is a DSPS exemption on the student contract and the names are to be forwarded to Admissions for Priority Registration purpose. Board Rule 8600 may be revised in the future to reflect Non-Credit exemption.

Basic Skills:

Campaign has started, Counselor has attended 14 sections with ASEPS completed.

Summer Bridge:

SSSP provided presentation at the Summer Bridge Orientation and also provided the lunch. There were about 65 students in attendance. Students were asked to complete the OAC process and will be closely followed.

Probation:

District will send out letter to Probation students and will make list available to Admissions Department. Plans to contact students and provide much needed workshops and counseling are in place. There are plans to increase contact with this population in Fall 2106.

Undecided:

SSSP staff uncovered a discrepancy in the DEC system where two of the screens do not talk to one another, S251 and S003 have conflicting information, making it difficult for Counselors to update major and educational goal.

Comevo:

Comevo contract has been finalized SSSP is working with the vendor to upload Orientation to the platform, and plans to complete this early Fall 2016.

Title IX:

The IX software was purchased and the link to the title IX presentation will be made available to students in the College Orientation. There was a recommendation that the link be made available to students in other locations on the WLAC web-site to increase access. More training is forth coming, there are plans to provide faculty with information on Flex day and also to offer title IX presentation on WLAC website on several webpages.

Non-Credit SSSP:

SSSP is working with Academic Affairs Non-Credit faculty to provide Non-Credit program and course information. SSSP is reaching out to these students in an effort to provide SSSP services. Counselors are making classroom on the spot orientations to the students providing Expressway information and assessment planning.

Professional Development Counseling:

CCCCO CAI is offering several opportunities to WLAC faculty to participate in Professional Development opportunities.
