The acclaimed Actors' Gang of Culver City, under the art direction of actor Tim Robbins, will be conducting a free master class at West Los Angeles College. Participants will be introduced to the Gang's interpretation of commedia dell' arte and relate how The Gang uses this physical theatrical style to inform performance, create character, interpret classics and create new pieces. This hands-on class focuses on emotional state work and creating characters through movement.

Veteran actors and Gang members Justin Zsebe and VJ Foster will conduct the workshop. Foster has taught the Gang performance style in workshops all over the world. He was recently nominated for an Ovation Award for Lead Actor by the LA Stage Alliance and his film credits include performances in Steven Spielberg's Indiana Jones and the Kingdom of the Crystal Skull, and the Oscar nominated films The Shawshank Redemption, The Insider, and Best Picture winner Million Dollar Baby.
