ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
Deadline: June 12, 2008

The Los Angeles Chapter of Executive Women International awards two scholarships of \$2500 each and one scholarship of \$1000 for a student with special needs. Scholarships are paid in two installments of \$1250 and \$500 respectively. The first installment will be paid to the winners in August of 2008 and the second installment will be paid for the following March 2009, provided the eligibility requirements are met.

ELIGIBILITY

Type 1 - Regular Scholastic Program

- Students must have a 3.2 grade point average or better (previous semester), carry at least nine (9) units, and be pursuing an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree. (Winners must continue to carry nine (9) units, the grade point average is reduced to 3.0 for the second increment.)
- Candidates must be residents of Southern California and be available for a personal interview on June 24, 2008 (6:30 in the evening in Pasadena) and be able to attend the Scholarship Program on August 14, 2008 (6 pm to 9 pm) at the Mayfair Hotel (Vanda Room) in Downtown Los Angeles.
- Scholarships are granted primarily on the basis of scholastic achievement.

Type 2 - Students Legally Identified by the State as Students with Special Needs

- Students must have a 2.0 grade point average or better (previous semester), carry at least nine (9) units, and be pursuing an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree. (Winners must continue to carry nine (9) units with a grade point average of 2.0.)
- Candidates must be residents of Southern California and be available for a personal interview on June 24, 2008 (6:30 in the evening in Pasadena) and be able to attend the Scholarship Program on August 14, 2008 (6 pm until 9 pm at the Mayfair Hotel (Vanda Room) in Downtown Los Angeles.
- Scholarships are granted primarily on the basis of scholastic achievement.

 - 1) A one-page essay stating your future aspirations and goals.

CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Students must be residents of Southern California and must be available for the following dates:

June 24, 2008 (6:30 in the evening in Pasadena) – Personal interview
August 14, 2008 (6:00 pm until 9:00 pm at the Mayfair Hotel in downtown Los Angeles)-Scholarship Awards Program

Scholarship winners will be announced in June 2008.
2. Students must have completed at least one semester at an accredited junior college in Southern California. If recommended by an EWI Los Angeles Chapter firm, students must have completed at least one semester at an accredited junior college, college or university in Southern California.

STUDENTS IN THE REGULAR SCHOLASTIC PROGRAM (two scholarships available at \$2,500 each)

3. Students in the regular scholastic program must be pursuing an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree, have a 2.0 Grade Point Average or above for the previous semester, currently carry nine (9) units or more. Winners must continue to carry nine (9) units and maintain a grade point average of 3.0 during the next semester to be eligible for the second installment.

STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS (one scholarship available at \$1,000)

4. Students with special needs must be pursuing an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree, have a 2.0 Grade Point Average or above for the previous semester, currently carry nine (9) units or more and be identified by the State of California as a student with special needs. Winners must continue to carry nine (9) units and maintain a grade point average of 2.0 the next semester to be eligible for the second installment.
 5. This application form must be completed in full and submitted along with:

A one-page essay stating the applicant's future aspirations and goals, and

A sealed, certified transcript from the last semester or quarter.
