What does the "ESL Referral" Mean?

Your scores on the English assessment suggest that you may need to build your skills in **English grammar** and **writing**.

- You may speak and understand two or more languages.
- You may speak and understand English very well, but your grammar, reading and / or writing may need more foundational work.

ESL writing and grammar classes provide extensive grammar and writing with 6 units.

ESL classes assist students who may not have the grammatical language skills necessary for writing and reading in English at the college level.

The chart below shows that ESL courses are equivalent to English course at West Los Angeles College. You have a choice. ESL is designed for students like you.
