1. All transcripts from other colleges attended (outside LACCD) must be on file in the Admissions Office				
2. <b>UNIT REQUIREMENT:</b> A minimum of 60 units of course credit in a selected Educational program.				
3. <b>SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENT:</b> A minimum of <b>2.0 (C)</b> grade point average.				
4. <b>RESIDENCE: Requirement Completion of at least 12 units in residence at WLAC</b> and attendance at the college in which the graduation requirements are completed.				
5. <b>MATHEMATICS COMPETENCY REQUIREMENT:</b> Completion of one of the following courses (or its equivalent at another college) with a grade of “C” or better: <b>Math 115, 116, 117 &amp; 118, 119, 146, 147, or higher math class; Computer Technology 60; Electronics 10, 12, 14; General Engineering Technology 121; Engineering Technology 49, 50, 51; or Statistics</b> OR Achievement of a score of 15 or higher on the District Mathematics Competency Examination. (Board Rule 6201.12/6201/14)

**DOUBLE COUNTING NOTE:** Courses may satisfy a general education requirement AND at the same time a requirement for the major up to a maximum of five courses. A minimum of **60 units**, however, must be completed for a degree. It is important to discuss proposed double-counting with a counselor.
